**ACA Navigator available** for one-on-one help: Beth Dyson, White Mountain Community Health Center's Health Insurance navigator, will be here for one-on-one assistance during open enrollment time for the Health Insurance Marketplace at the following times:

- **Wed. November 8** 1-8 pm
- **Wed. November 29** 1-8 pm
- **Wed. December 13** 1-8 pm

Assistance will be available on a drop in, first-come first-serve basis. You should bring your login information for Healthcare.gov. Beth encourages people to bring a list of the doctors, medical facilities and prescriptions that they use so she can make sure the plan they choose covers those. People should be prepared to update their income for 2018 which will impact the tax credits.

**Almost Sunrise** film and discussion; Come watch and discuss the film on Wed. Nov. 8 at 6:30 pm. This documentary film by Michael Collins and Marty Syjuco tells how, in an attempt to put haunting combat experiences behind them, two Iraq veterans embark on an epic 2,700-mile trek on foot across America, seeking redemption and healing as a way to close the moral chasm opened by war.
