Town Office news: Town Office, Tax Collector/Town Clerk's Office Closed until Further Notice. To address the concerns surrounding the COVID-19 virus, the Board of Selectmen have decided to close the Town Offices to the public. Business will continue, but we ask the public to perform any business with the Town by calling 323-7525. Committees have been asked to postpone planned meetings. If meetings, such as the Board of Selectmen cannot be postponed, then we are asking that the public limit their attendance.

Town Clerk/Tax Collector news: Office will be open by appointment only on Thursdays beginning March 19th, 2020 from 9:00 – Noon; 1-6 pm in order to process either “New” Motor Vehicle Registrations (1st Time) or the “transferring of plates”. Please call 603-323-7971 to set up an appointment. For those looking to “renew” their Motor Vehicle Registrations you may do so by postal mail. Call the Town Clerk's office and leave a message with your contact information so that we may call you back and give you the total cost of the registrations you wish to renew and instructions on how to complete the process. The on-line transaction fees will be reduced by \$1.50 at this time.

If you wish to pay property taxes, license your dog, or request a vital record you may leave a message with the Town Clerk/Tax Collectors office and we will return your call to give you the costs involved and the instructions necessary to complete these transactions by postal mail.

Tamworth Community Nurse news: Temporarily, the Tamworth Community Nurse Office will be closed to patient visits. If you need medications managed, dressings changed, blood work, and medical equipment loans, etc. CALL the TCNA office at 323-8511 or Jo Anne Rainville, RN at 651-9496 prior to coming to the office. Come to the TCNA back door and we will meet you in the parking lot. We are directing patients with risk factors for COVID-19 to call their medical provider for instruction.

Recreation Department news: With recent concerns of the Covid19 virus and the safety of the public and staff, all recreational activities have been cancelled until further notice. Rebecca Mason, Selectmen, Health Officer

Police Department news: In response to concerns surrounding COVID-19, we will be taking the following measures until further notice:

There will be no public access at our office, only employees and essential personnel will be allowed in, unless it is deemed an emergency. This will help to ensure that our officers and staff will not have unnecessary contact and limit their potential exposure to the virus. We ask that you communicate with us by phone, Office (603) 323-8581, Dispatch (603) 539-2284.

Furthermore, we will limit some of our public service responses that are not deemed necessary or emergent, and will handle each call on a case by case scenario.
