Tamworth Community Nurse news: TCNA has been handing out hand sanitizer to the residents of Tamworth in 8 oz containers since our Annual Town Meeting in March.

We have received a gift of “White Mountain” Hand Sanitizer crafted by your friends at Tamworth Distilling. When you are ready, it is available to refill those empty 8 oz. hand sanitizer bottles we have been handing out the last few weeks.

Call 323-8511 before coming by the office to pick up hand sanitizer or for us to refill your empty bottle - we will meet you at the back door.

Although the office is temporarily closed to regular patient visits, your nurses are out in the community working every day to support the health of the residents of Tamworth during this unusual time. Please do not hesitate to call the office if you have any questions. We are here for you!

The Tamworth Foundation has granted TCNA, The Food Pantry, and 68 Hours of Hunger with funds dedicated to meeting the nutritional needs of our residents. In addition to food stuffs, **we could use donations** of shampoo, soap, deodorant, laundry detergent, toothpaste, dish detergent, disposable razors, paper products, mouthwash, cleaning products, kitty litter, animal food, feminine hygiene products, etc., etc., etc.. You can drop off items at the TCNA back door or deliver them directly to the food pantry at St. Andrew's every other Wednesday (starting 3/15) from 3-7 p.m.

For eggs, supply is limited, but call us and we will accommodate you if we can. Our price on our eggs is now \$6.00, as our feeding cost has increased. We also have meat packages available to order on our website, www.whitegates-farm.com. Of course these are dependent on supply but we will let you know if we cannot fill your order.
