Circuit Court news: To expedite Emergency Guardianship over Adults Petitions during COVID-19 Crisis, electronic filings shall be heard within 48 hours. Given the anticipated surge in critical care patients with COVID-19, the Circuit Court announced today that it has developed temporary protocols for the electronic filing for an emergency expedited guardianship petition over an adult. Using either telephonic or videoconference services, the Circuit Court-Probate Division will now provide a limited number of hearings within a 48-hour period to determine when a guardianship appointment is necessary to make medical decisions for an incapacitated adult.
