Family Support Warm Line: The Waypoint Family Support Warm Line is a free phone-in service where callers can talk confidentially to a family support professional to get help with everything from coping strategies, child behaviors, family dynamics, household management and emotional distress, to gaining access to tools, resources, and services that can help navigate life during challenging times. Callers may need advice or just a trusted, nonjudgmental ear. Either way, it's a good way for families to feel less isolated and more supported.

Here are some details:

- The toll-free number is 1-800-640-6486 and there is never a charge for the service.
- The Warm Line service starts on Monday, April 6.
- You may phone into our Warm Line, 1-800-640-6486, anytime Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 4:30pm, and our call center will schedule you in with a family support professional.
- Each call may last up to one hour
- Family Support professionals will provide guidance and support on issues big or small, and may offer referrals to other Waypoint programs or other providers in the community
- NOTE: This is not a HOT-line. Emergency calls should still be made to 911. Urgent calls to Waypoint will be routed accordingly for prompt response.
- We're honored for the opportunity to serve New Hampshire families in their time of need. We hope you'll call us if/when you need help.


Town Office news: The Town Office personnel will be in the Town Office from 9 AM - 12 PM, Tuesdays - Fridays. On Mondays the office is closed. This does not include the Town Clerk/Tax Collector, whose hours are listed on the next page.

Town Clerk/Tax Collector: With recent concerns of the Covid-19 virus and the safety of our staff and the public as well, the Tamworth Town Clerk/Tax Collectors Office will be open by appointment only on Thursdays beginning March 19th, 2020 from 9:00 AM – Noon; 1-6 PM in order to process either “New” Motor Vehicle Registrations (1st Time) or the “transferring of plates,” either one of which cannot be done on-line.

For those looking to “renew” their Motor Vehicle Registrations at this current time that process can either be completed online at www.tamworthnh.org. On the Home Page on the left-hand side click on “On-Line Payments” and then choose the “orange” icon, or by postal mail. If by postal mail please call the Town Clerk’s office at (603) 323-7971 and leave a message with your contact information so that we may call you back and give you the total cost of the registrations you wish to renew and instructions on how to complete the process. The on-line transaction fees will be reduced by \$1.50 at this time.

If you wish to pay property taxes, license your dog, or request a vital record you may either use our online services or leave a message with the Town Clerk/Tax Collectors office and we will return your call to give you the costs involved and the instructions necessary to complete these transactions by postal mail.
