Supervisors of the Checklist update: PLEASE DISREGARD THE PREVIOUS INFORMATION FROM THE SUPERVISORS.

June 2 is the last day that registered voters can change their party affiliation until after the September 8 State Primary. The Supervisors of the Checklist will be meeting from 7:00 – 7:30 the evening of June 2 and voters may come at that time with change of party requests. Because the option of doing this prior to June 2 with the Town Clerk is not possible during the COVID-19 crisis, the Supervisors have tried to find a way to facilitate any changes or questions you might have regarding your voter registration. If you wish to change your party affiliation and are unable to come to our June 2 meeting, the best way will be to phone me at 603-960-0358 and I will arrange a time and place to meet you. If you are not sure of your current party designation or have other voting questions, I can answer these questions over the phone. If I do not answer the phone, please leave a message and I will return your call as soon as I can.

Please note that any forms that I accept when we meet will not be approved until the June 2 meeting.
